#### Chocolate Chip Cookies

Ingredients

#### Method

125g butter ½ cup brown sugar ⅓ cup caster sugar

1 egg

1 teaspoon vanilla essence

1½ cups self raising flour

 $\frac{3}{4}$  cup (or a bit more, shhh)

chocolate chips

- 1. Cream together butter and sugars until light and fluffy.
- 2. Whisk in egg and vanilla.
- 3. Stir in flour then fold through chocolate chips.
- 4. Place teaspoonful on greased baking trays.
- 5. Bake in a moderately slow oven for 160oC for 10-15 minutes or until cooked. Cool on a wire rack.
